

I had an increase in my income, will the Housing Authority raise my rent?

All changes in income must be reported to the Housing Authority, in writing, within 14-calendar days of occurrence. The Housing Authority will not increase your rent until your anniversary unless (a) there was a change in household composition, or (b) the household income was unstable at the last annual reexamination, or (c) the Housing Authority processed an interim (decrease) since the last annual reexamination. BHA may take different actions depending on whether the family reported the change voluntarily, or because it was required to do so.
