I received a letter from the Housing Authority and I misplaced it. I am not sure what I need to do?

It is important to open your mail from the Housing Authority as soon as you receive it. Often times you are required to take certain actions by a specific date. You don't want to be late and risking losing your assistance. That said, the Housing Authority retains a copy of all correspondence mailed to you. If you misplace your annual reexamination notice, or your inspection notice, contact your caseworker for assistance.
